
ORDER

This matter came before the court, Kafker, J., on the "Defendant's Emergency Petition for Relief from Order Revoking Bail Brought Pursuant to G. L. c. 211, § 3." The bail revocation order, dated December 26, 2023, summarily allowed the Commonwealth's motion seeking to revoke bail "pursuant to G. L. c. 276, § 58 for a period not to exceed 90 days."

The revocation of bail under G. L. c. 276, § 58 may not exceed a period of sixty days and requires written findings. See Josh J. v. Commonwealth, 478 Mass. 716, 718 (2018) (comparing sixty-day revocation period available under G. L. c. 276, § 58, to ninety-day revocation period available under G. L. c. 276, § 58B). It is thus ORDERED that this matter be remanded to the judge who issued the bail revocation order to make written findings in accord with G. L. c. 276, § 58. The

findings shall be filed with the Clerk of the Supreme Judicial Court for Suffolk County, by 4:00 p.m., Tuesday, February 13, 2024.
